CHICK APPOINTS NEDRA JENKINS TO CITY ETHICS COMMISSION

Los Angeles – Calling her “a strong and independent leader,” City Controller Laura Chick has nominated Nedra Jenkins to the City’s Ethics Commission.

“I am proud to have known Nedra for many years and have been impressed with her integrity and honesty. She will be an outstanding Ethics Commissioner and will bring her rich skills and experience to push for needed reforms in our ethics and campaign finance laws,” said Chick.

Jenkins is currently a Principal Deputy County Counsel in Los Angeles. A graduate UCLA’s School of Law, she has been named one of Southern California’s outstanding lawyers by Law and Politics magazine for the last four years. Nedra is the past president of Black Women Lawyers of Los Angeles.

“I want to take this opportunity to honor the extraordinary service of my first appointee to the Ethics Commission, Bill Boyarsky. Bill redefined the very definition of reformer. He was fearless to ask the tough questions and to uncover the truth. Too often he was the lone voice on the Commission to bring about real and substantive change to City Hall and to elections,” said Chick of Boyarsky whose five year term on the Ethics Commission expires next month.
